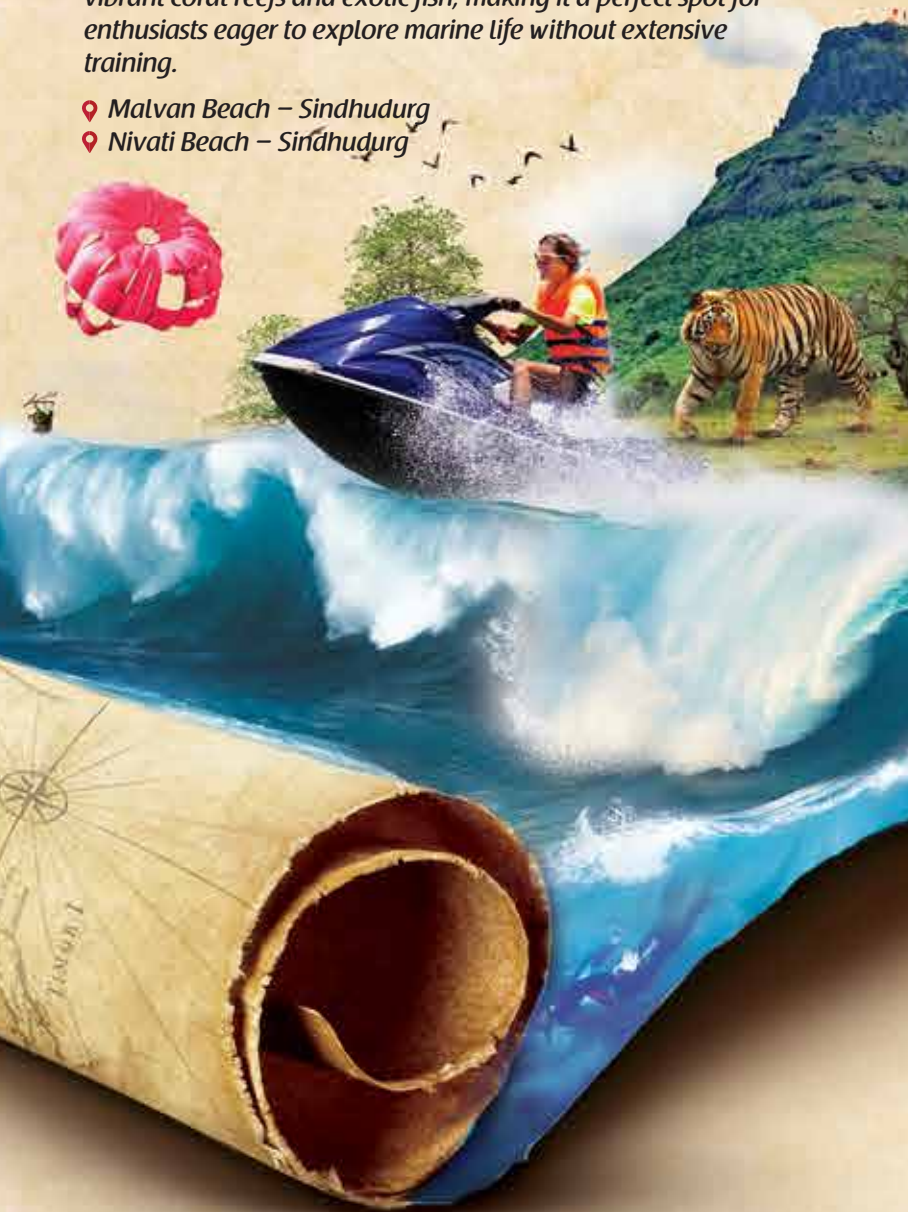

Soar like a bird and embrace exhilarating paragliding adventures in Maharashtra, renowned for its picturesque landscapes and thrilling outdoor pursuits.

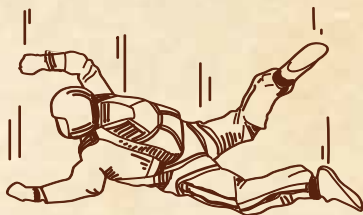
