



Jyotirlinga are twelve of the holiest shrines dedicated to Lord Shiva. There are three in Maharashtra - Bhimashankar, Trimbakeshwar and Ghrishneshwar. The remaining nine are located across India and include Somnath Temple (Veraval, Gujarat), Mallikarjuna (Srisailam, Andhra Pradesh), Mahakaleshwar (Ujjain, Madhya Pradesh), Omkareshwar (Khandwa, Madhya Pradesh), Kedarnath (Kedarnath, Uttarakhand), Vishwanath (Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh), Vaidyanath (Deoghar, Jharkhand), Nageshwar (Dwarka, Gujarat), Rameshwar (Rameshwaram, Tamil Nadu).

Regarded as Lord Shiva's authentic or Swayambhu form, the word Jyotirlinga is derived from jyoti (light) and linga (mark or sign) and means the 'radiant sign of Lord Shiva'. Devotees visiting the three Jyotirlinga in Maharashtra often pray at Aundha Naganath and Shri Vaijnath Mandir Parli temples too.






TRIMBAKESHWAR TEMPLE (NASHIK DISTRICT)

One of the most sacred sites in Hindu mythology, the Shiva Linga at the temple has three faces, representing the three supreme deities - Brahma, Vishnu and Maheshwara. The Godavari River originates at Trimbakeshwar and it is believed that anybody who visits the temple will attain salvation.

BHIMASHANKAR TEMPLE (TUNE DISTRICT)

Lord Shiva is worshipped in the Ardhanareeshwara form. Devotees who come here also take a dip in the Bhima River. The legends claim that the river originated from Lord Shiva's perspiration as he sweated after his battle with the demon, Tripurasura. Bathing in its waters is said to wash away one's sins.

GHRISHNESHWAR TEMPLE (CHHATRAPATI SAMBHAJI NAGAR DISTRICT)

This is considered to be the last of the 12 sacred Shiva shrines, and is the final stop of the Jyotirlinga Yatra for devotees. However, the belief is that pilgrims who visit only Ghrishneshwar are as blessed as those who offer prayers at every Jyotirlinga. This holy place is close to Ellora Caves.

OTHER PROMINENT SHIVA TEMPLES

AUNDHA NAGNATH TEMPLE (HINGOLI DISTRICT)

According to the myths surrounding this temple, it was constructed by Yudhishthira, the eldest Pandava while he was in exile with his brothers. The temple has exquisite carvings and is spread across an area of 60,000 square feet. It is a shining example of the Hemadpanthi style of architecture.

How to reach

- By Rail: Hingoli (26 kms), Parbhani (52 kms)
- By Road: Hingoli (24 kms), Parbhani (56 kms), Nanded (70 kms), Aurangabad (200 kms)

SHRI VAIJNATH TEMPLE PARLI (BEED DISTRICT)

This ancient temple is surrounded by mountains and dense forests full of medicinal and healing plants. The deity here is said to have healing powers, which is why he is called Vaijnath. Devotees offer prayers and touch the Shiva Linga as they believe that it can cure and protect them from illnesses.

How to reach

★ By Air: Aurangabad (225 kms)

By Rail: Parli (3 kms)

By Road: Aundha Nagnath (120 kms)
