




Surrounded by hills and enveloped in serenity, a visit to the sanctuary is the

perfect antidote for the blues.

Several animals live within the scenic forest including sloth bears, tigers, leopards, jungle cats, small Indian civet and four horned antelopes. There are nearly 13 endangered bird species. The most notable among them is the bar-headed goose. The forest also has 200 species of medicinal plants as well as other plants of economic importance.










The serenity of the Karnala Bird Sanctuary is often punctuated by the chatter and whistle of our feathered friends. A bird lovers' paradise, this avian hotspot has 147 species of resident birds, while 37 species of migratory birds arrive here from across the world in winter. The sanctuary also has an amazing array of butterflies. The destination is also popular among trekkers, who can be seen on the trails leading to the Karnala fort in the centre of the sanctuary.
